<p><u>CHNA Research:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Asthma / allergies was the largest (by far) mentioned health issue</li> <li>• More than half of parents report their children having allergies</li> <li>• 1 in 3 parents report their children having asthma</li> </ul> <p><u>Key Root Causes:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Home environments with issues like mold and secondhand, thirdhand smoke that go undetected and untreated</li> <li>• Messaging of how to manage child's asthma may differ from hospital to provider to school to parent to child</li> <li>• Misuse of inhalers / medication</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reinstate the Suncoast Pediatric Asthma Coalition (SPAC) to lead CBSIP effort, as well as to gain access to grants and resources. <i>Systems change</i></li> <li>• Advocate for change to municipal codes related to carpeting, second-hand and third-hand tobacco smoke in residential housing. <i>Policy change</i></li> <li>• Increase number of home assessments following hospital visits in order to identify triggers in home. <i>environment.
